

### About Beach Crows

Beach Crows are an emerging band based in Lothian & Borders. They formed in 2020 when the core members Al Nicholas and Tom Anderson developed their songwriting collaboration into a band that now features Nick Townsend on Bass and Ali McLeod on drums.

Whether mellow, groovy or straight up foot-stomping, their music is rooted in the interplay of guitar parts, a genuine feel for melody and well-crafted lyrics. Influences thread through folk rock, blues and jazz with an occasional burst of funk.

As musicians, members of Beach Crows have played in the UK's most prominent venues (Royal Albert Hall, 100 Club, Cafe Royal, Half Moon Putney ) as well as in USA (Nashville) and at major UK festivals (Wallingford Bunkfest, Edinburgh Jazz n Blues, Reading Jazz & Blues Festival. Radio and TV appearances include Radio BBC Berkshire, Radio Solent, London TV Critics Awards. As session and touring musicians over the years they have played for artists such as 170 Split, Marmalade, Lamahl, Matt Holland (Van Morrison) & Tom Richards (Jamie Cullum).

Having played pubs, clubs and festivals across Lothian & Borders, they are planning a tour of smaller local venues and festivals across Scotland, both with a band and as a duo. They launched their first EP at a sell-out performance during the Biggar Little Festival in 2023.
